

HOW TO ACCESS COMMUNITY CHORUS RECORDINGS ON iTUNESU

If you don't have it already, you'll need to [download iTunes](#) to your PC or Mac in order to access BCC on iTunesU. It's free. Here's the URL in case the hyperlink above doesn't work:

Once you've installed iTunes on your computer, do the following:

- Navigate to www.brevardcc.edu.
- Select <Faculty & Staff> from the banner at the top.
- Select <Academic Technology> from the top of the list of options.
- Select <BCC on iTunesU> under "Applications" on the left.
- Click on <BCC on iTunesU Public Access> (first on the list).
- A Launch Application box will open and iTunes will be highlighted. Click <OK>.
- iTunes will launch on your computer (if it's not already open) and you'll be taken to BCC's iTunesU site.
- Click on the <Fine & Applied Arts> folder (left-most column, fourth item down).
- Click on the folder entitled <Lamb_Robert_E>.
- Slide the slider over to the right. You'll see a tab called "Comm Chorus Fall 2010."
- From here, you may simply play each track individually, or you may download them and burn them to a CD or to your mp3 player.
